Definition of Indirect Costs of Research

The indirect costs of conducting research are costs that are borne by an institution related to research, but not directly related to the research itself. These costs include overhead expenses such as salaries for research support staff, administrative costs, and institutional overhead. Dawson College allocates a portion of its Research Support Fund to cover these indirect costs.
